## RHYTHM ROUGE

A subtle combination of parallel and perpendicular lines remind of the early architectural structure of the Hermès brand.

The design of the Rhythm collection reflects the whirlwind and complexity of inner-city reality.

Movement, speed, the flow of information... it captures an effervescent city setting moderated by the whiteness of porcelain, and the elegance and discretion of the drawing which honours the canvas and its contents.



## MESCLUN

Beautiful and larger than life.

The idea for this collection, came to designer Leigh Cooke while strolling through his garden. He collected countless leaves and applied these to the edge of the porcelain.

The choice of green and yellow remind of the freshness of this day and the pattern is warmed through the hints of plum. These subtle colour nuances emphasize the finesse of the drawn strokes.

The design sprouts to life through the process of chromolithography, and the shadows bring realism to the design produced with the trompe l'oeil technique.



## CENTURY

With its alternating chocolate tints, browns and matte platinum, the Century Collection is rich in many inspirations and displays discrete finesse.

The geometrical forms of the Art Deco style, and the clean architectural lines of New York's skyscrapers which combine metal and wood, are two themes very dear to the Puiforcat name.



## FIL D'ARGENT

The 14 pieces of the Fil d'Argent Collection are the first ever drawn by Henri d'Origny. Inspired by the Equestrian universe, we see the same timeless style of an illustrator, whose name has been associated with the Hermès tie for the last 50 years.

Taken from this legacy, the three chains decorating the porcelain elegantly combine round mesh, loops and arabesques on silky backgrounds where the white colour lightens the sobriety of the grey shades.

The Fil d'Argent design is a feat obtained by chromolithography, in which the patterns brilliance is increased through an individual polishing of each piece.

A sophisticated urban collection which brings allure and elegance to the table.
