Light & Crisp

Petit Ballon Blanc 2014/15 (France) £12.95

An uplifting, zesty blend from Gascony, bursting with crisp green apples, tangy grapefruit and a racy, mouth-watering freshness.

Pinot Grigio "Luna" Cecilia Beretta 2015 (Italy) £14.50

This outstanding Pinot Grigio shows floral and almond notes, with ripe citrus fruit and a subtle minerality.

Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine de Morin Langaran 14/15 (France) £16.00

This wine is both gentle and refreshing with notes of Mediterranean white peach, apricot kernel and zesty lime peel culminating in a silky mouth-feel and crisp, vibrant acidity.

Mont de Joie Sauvignon Blanc 2014 (France) £17.50

Delicious, zesty Sauvignon from vineyards close to Sancerre, made by the region's star performer: Henri Bourgeois.

Chablis 1er Cru Vaillons, Domaine Vincent Dampt 2014 (France) £31.00

The nose shows pure citrus and orchard fruits. The palate has crushed sea-shell minerality and a rich creaminess.

Fresh & Aromatic

Lowry's Pass Chenin Blanc 2015 (South Africa) £13.50

Great value, modern South African Chenin Blanc. Light, zesty and equally enjoyable with food or on its own.

Terre de Lumière Viognier 2014/15 (France) £14.50

Elegant, Southern French Viognier offering outstanding value! Reminiscent of acacia blossom and white peaches.

Santa Florentina Organic 'Fairtrade' Chardonnay 2015 (Argentina) £15.00

Ultra fresh, Organic Chardonnay with 'Fairtrade' status to boot! Produced in Argentina's oldest winemaking province: the Famatina Valley.

Rheingau Riesling QbA Schloss Schonborn 2013 (Germany) £21.00

This Riesling is light in alcohol at 11.5%, off dry, with ripe apple and peach fruits, a distinct creaminess and fresh acidity. An excellent aperitif but also a fabulous food wine.

Sancerre, Domaine du Nozay 2014 (France) £27.00

Multi-award winning Sancerre from passionate, winemaking family dedicated solely to the pursuit of making perfect Sauvignon Blanc.

Ripe & Fruity

Casa Felipe Sauvignon Blanc 2015 (Chile) £14.00

Crisp, aromatic and refreshing from Chile's Valle Central. Perfect with seafood and salads, it offers citrus fruit aromas and herbaceous notes over a soft, creamy texture.

Belezos Rioja Blanco, Bodegas Zugober 2012 (Spain) £21.00

Made by Bodegas Zugober, a family winery in the heart of the Rioja Alavesa region. This Rioja Blanco is rich but elegant, combining fruit and spice.

Erardus Sauvignon Blanc 2014 (New Zealand) £24.00

A distinctive style of Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc with intense fruit flavours and aromatic depth.

Veigadares Albarino Adegas Galegas 2012 (Spain) £25.00

Spicy peach notes and floral aromas make this wine distinctive. With a lovely body weight and full, tropical palate, this wine is delicious by itself or an ideal accompaniment to seafood.

Rosé Wine

Fruity & Fresh

Petit Ballon Rosé 2014/15 (France) £12.95

A fruity, easy drinking Rosé, blended by Corney & Barrow's Buying Team for the perfect balance of fruit and acidity.

Light & Delicate

Château La Tour de L'Éveque Rosé 2014/15(France) £17.50

Pale pink in colour with fresh, expressive raspberry and rose hip flavours, enhanced by a light creamy mouthfeel. A fine but moreish glassful, Tour makes the perfect aperitif, or a superb match for light fish recipes, cheese dishes and Asian cooking.

Pétale de Rose, Château La Tour de L'Éveque Rosé 2014/15 (France) £27.00

Delicate aromas of white blossom, rose petals and strawberry on the nose. Subtle on the palate, this wine displays ripe red fruits and crisp minerality over a luscious creamy texture, culminating in a clean, refreshing finish.

Red Wine

Fruity & Smooth

Petit Ballon Rouge 2014 (France) £12.95

Located in the heart of the ancient, sun-baked Haut Minervois region, Celliers Jean d'Alibert blend Grenache and Syrah from old vines to produce this medium bodied, velvety wine which is full of rich plum fruit and savoury spice.

Terre de Lumière Grenache - Syrah 2014 (France) £13.50

Authentic, local expression of Grenache and Syrah from low-yielding old vines in the sun-baked Languedoc-Roussillon.

Chamuyo Malbec 2015 (Argentina) £15.00
A great introduction to Argentina's signature varietal from classic Mendoza province, Chamuyo Malbec is a juicy, supple wine with ripe summer fruits, herbs and warm spice.

Merlot "Belvedere" Cecilia Beretta 2014 (Italy) £15.00
Soft and velvety red wine from prestige winery making small quantities of high quality wines in the Veneto, North East Italy. Cecilia Beretta's Belvedere Merlot is ruby red with velvety tannins and a smooth, milk chocolate finish.

Fleurie Grand-Pré, Domaine Lathuilière Gravelon 2014 (France) £21.00
This Fleurie displays sweet red gamay fruit, as well as an impressive finesse and body drawn from its pink granite soils.

Beaune Les Teurons 1er Cru, Domaine Rossignol-Trapet 2013 (France) £51.00
Bright and vivacious on attack it has great energy and drive, supported by rounded, supple tannins through to a protracted, mocharich, yet sprightly finish - lovely wine.

Rich & Spicy

Shiraz Heywood Estate 2014 (Australia) £13.50
This wine is made exclusively from prime vineyard sites in South Eastern Australia. The fruit from these old vines is rich and concentrated, producing a wine with spicy dark berries, baked plum and hints of white pepper.

Côtes du Rhône, Vignobles Gonnet 2013 (France) £17.50
This Côtes du Rhone is exceptional for its elegance and structure, exuding all the violet, dried herb and spicy dark fruit for which the appellation is famous.

Belezos Rioja Crianza, Bodegas Zugober 2012 (Spain) £21.00
Clean and intense aromas of red fruit and spicy notes follow to the palate which displays rich plum, dark cherry fruit and warm spices.

Mourvèdre Grenache Syrah, Rhebokskloof 2012 (South Africa) £21.00
This classic Rhone blend displays juicy dark bramble fruit, sweet spice and elegantly balanced freshness. An opulent wine it is smooth and elegant but bursting with dark fruit flavours, clove and sweet spices.

Quinta de Chocopalha Tinto 2011 (Portugal) £23.00
Fragrant, leafy, black fruit carries through to a fine, vibrantly fruited palate, complemented by layers of dark chocolate, tobacco, spice and fresh herbs.

Perfumed & Elegant

Domaine de Saissac Cabernet Sauvignon 2013 (France) £14.50
Delicious flavours of blackcurrant and light tannins make a lovely wine that's a delight to drink on its own. You won't be disappointed!

Valpolicella Superiore Ripasso, Cecilia Beretta 2013 (Italy) £24.00
Made from local grape varieties, this wine is rich, full-bodied and deep garnet in colour. The nose displays intense aromas of prunes and wild cherries with savoury toasted notes.

Eradus Pinot Noir 2014 (New Zealand) £29.00
The Eradus family winemaking philosophy centres on achieving wines with ripeness, balance and freshness. This Pinot Noir blends earthy mushroom notes with dark, perfumed fruit and flowers.

Château de Lamarque 2012 (France) £35.00
Located between St Julien and Margaux, this chateau has an outstanding reputation. The wine has sweet, black Cabernet fruit, blackcurrant and cedar with moderate tannins and a ripe finish.

Sparkling Wine & Champagne

Sylvoz, Prosecco Le Colture Brut NV (Italy) £21.00
Le Colture, based in Valdobbiadene, are true sparkling wine experts. Over 500 years of experience have led this old-established family to produce a world class Prosecco: light and delicate, with notes of orchard fruit and white flowers.

Sparkling Rosé Le Colture Brut NV (Italy) £21.00
This hand-made sparkling rosé wine is the perfect party pink! It has a lovely, delicate mousse and ripe, red berry flavours.

Bodega Ruca Malen Sparkling Brut NV (Argentina) £22.50
This sparkler has a unique look with bright golden bubbles enhanced by a copper hue. The ripe stone fruit, creamy feel and toasted almond touch will fill your glass with joy.

Wiston Estate Brut NV (England) £35.00
Family run Wiston Estate is nestled in the heart of England's South Downs and is made by the same method and using the same grapes as champagne. Every investment has been made in the unrelenting pursuit of quality to produce a new benchmark for English sparkling wine. Their Brut NV has the fragrance and fruit of an English orchard, an elegant texture of fine bubbles and a clean freshening finish.

Wiston Estate Brut Rosé 2011 (England) £45.00
Incredibly moreish, this English sparkling rosé is surprising for its structural precision and textural finesse. Delicate and fine, this is a refreshing, inviting sparkling wine with the profile of raspberries and cream.

Delamotte Brut NV (France) £46.00
One of the oldest houses, Delamotte's champagnes remains hand crafted. The high proportion of Grand Cru Chardonnay gives this non-vintage blend a lovely balance of fresh, well-rounded, rich fruit and floral notes. A clean, crisp vibrancy finishes a beautiful wine.

Delamotte Rosé Brut NV (France) £56.00
Champagne Delamotte's Rosé is a blend of 80% Pinot Noir and 20% Chardonnay from Grand Cru vineyards. Delamotte still produces its rosé by the 'saignée' method, a highly-skilled technique employed by a few discerning Champagne houses. Delamotte Rosé is all elegance and finesse with appealing wild strawberry fruit.

Sweet Wine & Port

Château Septy 2011 Halves (France) £13.50
Here we have a delectable nose, rich in a combination of exotic and citrus fruit, with honeyed notes. The palate is richly-textured yet has a vibrant flash of zest which gives focus and direction.

Corney & Barrow Ruby Port (Portugal) £21.00
Matured for three years in seasoned oak. A serious ruby port, intensely coloured, rich and peppery.
